Amyris fragrance oil (often referred to as West Indian Sandalwood) is a versatile, cost-effective essential oil widely utilized in the production of daily-use perfumes, cosmetics, and functional fragrances. Derived from the steam distillation of the Amyris balsamifera tree, native primarily to Haiti, this oil is a staple in the fragrance and flavor industry for its unique structural and olfactive properties.

It features a deep, warm, woody, and balsamic aroma with subtle creamy undertones and a faint peppery top note. While it lacks the sharp sweetness of Indian Sandalwood, it offers a sophisticated, dry woodiness that is highly sought after for masculine and unisex formulations. In production, Amyris is prized as a natural fixative. Its high molecular weight and tenacity allow it to anchor more volatile top and middle notes, significantly extending the longevity of the final perfume on the skin.

Product Profile

The olfactive structure of Amyris Essence Oil is characterized by its remarkable stability and "slow-release" aromatic profile. While Amyris is predominantly a base-heavy material, its evolution on the skin provides a nuanced journey essential for professional perfume compounding.

Top Notes	The initial impression is characterized by a subtle, peppery brightness and a faint, balsamic freshness. Unlike the sharp citrus of many essential oils, the top notes of Amyris are muted and "dry," offering a clean, slightly resinous opening that prevents the fragrance from feeling overly heavy in the first few seconds of application.
Middle Notes	As the oil warms, it reveals a creamy, herbaceous core. This stage is defined by a soft woodiness that mimics the texture of polished timber. It acts as a bridge, smoothing the transition between volatile florals and heavy resins, often imparting a "guaiac-like" smoky sweetness that adds complexity to the heart of a fragrance.
Base Notes	This is where Amyris excels. The dry-down is a rich, balsamic, and persistent woody anchor. It provides a foundational warmth that mimics authentic Sandalwood (<i>Santalum album</i>), characterized by a long-lasting, earthy depth that can linger for several days on textile or paper strips.

Applications & Functions

In the fragrance and flavor industry, Amyris oil serves primarily as a natural fixative and structural modifier. Due to its high concentration of sesquiterpene alcohols (such as valerianol and eudesmol), it possesses a very low evaporation rate, which allows it to "anchor" more volatile top notes like citrus or light florals, significantly increasing the olfactive longevity of a perfume. Beyond its fixative role, it functions as a harmonizing blender; its mild, balsamic-woody profile is less assertive than traditional sandalwood, allowing it to smooth out "harsh" edges in synthetic formulations without dominating the scent profile. Additionally, it provides antioxidant and antimicrobial benefits, which can contribute to the stability of the final product and offer secondary skin-soothing properties in "treatment-focused" fragrances. Its high viscosity also lends a luxurious, emollient "feel" to oil-based perfumes.

Application	Description
Fine Fragrances & Colognes	It is a staple base note in woody, oriental, and fougere perfumes, often used as a sustainable and cost-effective alternative to endangered East Indian Sandalwood (<i>Santalum album</i>).
Personal Care & Cosmetics	Due to its excellent alkali stability, it is highly favored for scenting bar soaps, detergents, and shampoos, where it retains its aroma even in high-pH environments. It is also integrated into anti-aging creams and lotions for its skin-regenerating reputation.
Home Fragrance	It is a key component in candles, reed diffusers, and incense (bakhoors). In these applications, it provides a steady "cold throw" and acts as a carrier for other essential oils.
Flavor & Tobacco	In specialized industrial sectors, Amyris is used as a flavoring agent to add depth and "woody" complexity to tobacco products and certain liqueurs.
